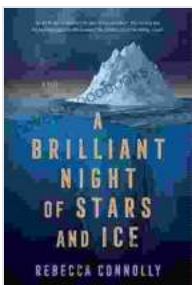


Brilliant Night of Stars and Ice

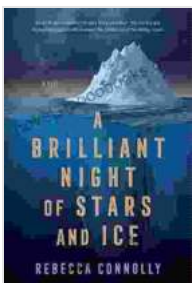

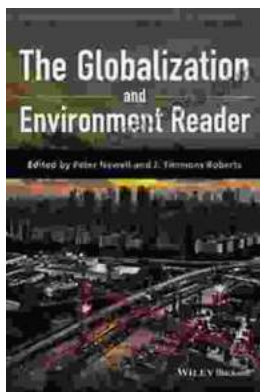
